Simulating digestion in the stomach

- o Question: How does the stomach digest the food we eat?
- o Hypothesis: It uses fats/ acids/
- o Conducting experiments:

Materials: fruit, baggies and fats (sunflower or olive oil) for experiment 1, and acids (lemon juice or vinegar) for experiment 2

Experiment1: put the fruit in the baggie and soak in sunflower oil or olive oil.

Experiment 2: put the fruit in the baggie and soak in lemon juice or vinegar.



- o Observation: students keep track of their observations making use of the observation table.
- o *Conclusion*: students make conclusions based on their observations in the 2 experiments.

The expected result is that the fruit (food, in general) soaked in lemon juice decomposed (was digested), and this how the stomach digests the food we eat using stomach acid.
